White Wine

Broken Shackle Semillon, Chardonnay, Chenin. Australia (13.5%)

Crikey! What a blend! Semillon, Chardonnay and Chenin Blanc mate.. Clean crisp palate is enhanced by subtle honey flavours. A bit aromatic, a bit tropical fruit, a bit too easy to drink!

Sollazzo Trebbiano Grachetto, Umbria Italy IGT (12%)

Lovely bright white stone fruit characters of pear with a slightly herby edge and bundles of character make this a great wine for the price. Beats the pants off other Italian quaffing whites! A well structured wine with a nice minerality and hints of citrus and orange peel.

Sollazzo Premio Pinot Grigio, Umbria, Italy (12.5%)

The grapes are softly crushed and fermented in temperature controlled stainless steel tanks. The wine is then left to rest in tank until bottled. The wine is fresh with tropical fruit and flinty tones, well structured with a lingering finish.

Opal Ridge Gewurztraminer Verdelho 2008 SE Australia (12.5%)

Thrilling Aussie original combining the spicy Gewurztraminer grape (of Alsace) with Madeira's exotic Verdelho - both of which have proven to be star performers Down Under. Together they provide a riot of floral and citrus fruit flavours and aromas.

Tierra Antica Sauvignon Blanc, Central Valley, Chile (12.5%)

Light and delicate yellow in colour, with delicious aromas of melon, apple and grapefruit showing on the nose. The palate is equally as charismatic, with passion fruit and mineral characteristics appearing. Perfectly fresh and fruity.

Hazy View Chenin Blanc, South Africa (13.5%)

Made from a selection of high quality grapes grown in South Africa's Western Cape. -Appealing medium straw colour, star bright and clean. The nose is fresh and aromatic with forthcoming peachy flavours. Crisp acidity on the palate. Finishes on a long fruity note. £17.50

Echeverria Unwooded Chardonnay, Curico valley, Chile (13.5%)

From a family owned and run winery, this unoaked chardonnay has a fresh and gentle aroma of fruits and flowers, and a delicate fruity flavour with hints of pears and apples that lingers elegantly on the finish. £19.90

Ondarre Rivallana Blanco Rioja (11.5%)

The Blanco Rivallana is a delicious, balanced, fresh white Rioja made from the Viura grape. Pale gold in colour with metallic glints and great luminosity, its nose is elegant and complex, with aromas of white flowers, flint and very ripe fruit (melon and stewed fruit). £19.90

Oveja Negra Chardonnay-Viognier Central Valley, Chile (13.5%)

"Oveja Negra" means black sheep and these Chilean vineyards couldn't reflect that ethos more. The end result is a well-balanced and fruit forward mix of young pear, cloudberry and mango notes rounded off with a delicious 'spice-cabinet' finish. £19.90

Deinhard's 'Green Label' Riesling (10.5%)

Pure Riesling sourced solely from Bereich Bernkastel. Complex yet elegant it is crisp & skilfully vinified. Very enjoyable and delicate off-dry wine with a crisp "slatey" finish. From a very old house (1794), whose name is synonymous with quality. £19.90

Faultline Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough, New Zealand (13%)

A full and crisp wine with intense aromas and flavours of passion fruit, blackcurrant, underlying gooseberry and herbal tones. Mouth-watering acidity is balanced by a full flavoured palate that leads to a long lingering finish.. £20.90

Frascati Superiore D.o.c. Poggio le Volpi, Lazio, Italy (13%)

Made from a blend of malvasia with bombino and a touch of sauvignon to give an elegant wine, showing fresh pineapple combined with lemon sherbert on the palate, truly delicious. £21.90

Carmen Gewurztraminer Reserva Casablanca Valley, Chile (13.5%)

This wine shows a greenish yellow colour. Fully aromatic on the nose this wine is rich and crispy with mandarin and orange peel aromas, intense roses, melon, mango lychee and Turkish delight. The mouth is fresh and complex, mineral tones add a vibrant edge. £21.90

Grand Vin de Bourgogne, Chablis, France (12.5%)

Refreshingly clean with a crisp, mineral and dry finish. Made in a fuller style with longer ageing on the lees to give weight. Chablis is separate from Burgundy, not only as a vineyard area, but also as a district, while the vineyards which produce champagne, lie only 25km away. £24.90

Sancerre Chateau de Chauvenay, Loire Valley, France (13%)

Intense mineral notes with good weight and a stylish dry, long finish. A clear pale yellow wine with light gold tones and a complex and subtle aroma of citrus and spring blossoms with notes of Flintstone The harmony of this wine comes from its excellent balance: lively, yet round. £27.90

Red Wine

Broken Shackle Shiraz Merlot, Australia (13%)

An exciting new blend that captures the best attributes of both varieties. The wine has vibrant crimson red colour and the aromas are dark cherry, blackberries, nutmeg with fragrant bay leaf and rosemary notes. The palate is lively, exhibiting intense forest fruit flavours wonderfully offset by spicy oak and a background of aromatic dried herbs.

Sollazzo Sangiovese Merlot, Umbria IGT, Italy (12.5%)

A fruit-laden, round and easy drinking red wine redolent of summer fruits. An impressive wine at this price with plenty of dark and red fruit and a lovely touch of toffee on the finish.

Chateau du Campuget Syrah Viognier, France (13%)

Chateau de Campuget is a top quality family owned estate in Costieres de Nimes with a history dating back several centuries. Fragrant nose, violets and soft blackfruit characters make this wine refreshing and easy to drink.

Sacchetto Merlot delle Venezie, Italy (12%)

100% Merlot grapes from hillside vineyards of the Veneto, Trentino & Friul. An easy drinking and balanced wine with berried fruits and soft tannins. This wine has a lovely, vibrant colour and a ripe, fresh nose.

Rivallana Rioja Tinto, Spain (13%)

Made at Bodegas Ondare, whose winery in Viana is just 10KM from Logrono, the Rioja capital, this wine is made in a modern, unoaked style, the wine is full of vibrant summer fruit. Well balanced, soft and approachable.

Hazy View Pinotage South Africa (14.5%)

Quite a classical example of Pinotage. A good deep ruby colour with interesting, slightly smoky berry fruit flavours and a touch of tobacco. Hints of stewed plums with a juicy style of fruit on the palate and ripe tannins. Delicious. £17.90

Vina Edmara Pinot Noir, Central Valley, Chile (13%)

This Pinot Noir shows a seductive and complex combination of black cherry and raspberry aromas, Rose petals and Violets, mingled with a soft touch of Vanilla and coconut. It is full-bodied and rich, with a soft and velvety texture, smooth tannins and elegant aftertaste. £18.90

Cuma ORGANIC malbec, Cafayate Valley, Argentina (13.5%)

With a lively red-violet color, the wine has opulent aromas of bright cherry and plum jam, with raisin, vanilla and rosemary notes. On the palate, there is ripe fruit, with date and raisin flavors, and soft and sweet tannins. There's a trace of nuts and spices on the long finish. £19.90

Beau Rivage Claret, Bordeaux, France (12.5%)

A soft, easy drinking wine produced from different "terroirs" and skillfully blended to ensure consistency in style and quality from year to year. Classic Claret style - very smooth and moreish - a beautifully balanced blend of Cabernet Sauvignon and Merlot grapes £19.90

Berton Black Shiraz, Berton Vineyards, Australia (14.5%)

Intense colour, huge palate and high in alcohol, vanilla, ripe plums and black cherries on the nose. The palate shows intense berry and rich fruit cake characters underpinned by layers of coffee and toasty oak that carry through to a lovely soft finish. £20.00

Rioja Crianza, Quasar, Spain (13.5%)

Elegant wine displaying notes of spice & leather, bursting with soft liquorice & vanilla characters. Powerful fruit aromas, well combined with hints of oak ageing. On the palate, it reveals concentrated, ripe fruit flavours and good structure. £21.00

Chianti Classico, Black rooster, Bonacchi, Tuscany, Italy (13%)

A careful selection of Sangiovese grapes grown on the Fattoria Casalino estate near Siena, owned by Bonacchi. The wine carries the Gallo Nero seal on the neck of the bottle. Ruby red in colour, the wine is soft harmonious and velvety with a bouquet reminiscent of violets. £22.50

Parducci Zinfandel, Mendocino County, California (14%)

A characteristically robust and spicy wine. The nose offers ripe scents of jammy blackberry, blueberry and raspberry fruits with a pronounced pepper tone. On the palate the wine's rich, spicy brambleberry flavours are bright and zesty, with balancing sturdy tannins. £22.50

Domaine du grand tinel châteauneuf-du-pape (15%)

A classic Chateauneuf-du-Pape blend including Grenache, Syrah, Cinsault, Mourvedre and Counoise aged in oak. Sweet, with plenty of fruit aromas, earthy mineral notes and honeysuckle. The palate has fruit, some pepper and thyme with a coating of tannin on the finish. £29.90

Sparkling Wine & Champagne

Tenute San Marco Prosecco (11%)

Sparkling wine obtained from Prosecco grapes, with a delicately fruity and distinguished bouquet it fills the mouth with a fresh apply flavour and fine, creamy mousse. It's light and delicate yet flavoursome, thirst-quenching and uplifting.

Pinot Rosa Frizzante Igt Venezia Sacchetto Vini, Veneto, Italy (11%)

Rosehip pink Pinot Noir with a small percentage of Pinot Bianco. This semi-sparkling rosé wine owes its bubbles to a partial second fermentation in tank... Fruity berry bouquet, balanced and lively with a refreshing finish.

De'Or Pinot Grigio Blush Spumante (11.5%)

Lightly sparkling pink Pinot Grigio with a soft succulent fruit and a crisp, fresh finish. One to enjoy liberally whatever the weather. £20.90

Ondarre Cava Sparkling Brut, Spain (11.5%)

100% Viura grapes, straw yellow with golden highlights, fine, long lasting bubbles, intense fruity nose, fresh & lively on the palate, full rounded flavours with a clean crisp finish and a hint of lemon . A dry full sparkling wine with a fruity fragrance and a clean fresh taste that is a level above ordinary Cava!! £20.90

Berton Vineyards Head over Heels Sparkling Chardonnay Victoria, Australia (13%)

This Sparkling Chardonnay displays raisins, toffee apple and honey on the nose which are complemented by characters of oranges and pink lady apples on the palate. Mouth filling and rich with a wonderfully voluptuous creaminess and well balanced by zingy acidity. £22.50

Moutard Grande Cuvee Champagne (12%)

A cuvee with a Pinot Noir base and aged on the lees for at least three years. Fine, rich, developed nose with fragrances of butter, almond and brioche. £35.00

Moutard Prestige Rosé Champagne (12%)

A beautiful Champagne in a distinctive style. Subtle with complexity, floral senses and essences of red fresh fruit such as raspberries and wild strawberries, evolving toward peppery and spicy aromas. £37.00

Mumm Cordon Rouge Champagne (12%)

A straightforward, great-value fizz with pedigree and history - the brand has been delighting palates with its citrus and fresh fruit character for over a hundred years - it was decorated with the Cordon Rouge label in tribute to France's Legion d'Honneur in the 19th century. Rich fleshy fruits with toasted nuts and subtle yeasty overtones. Fresh, elegant and balanced with a long, creamy finish. £37.00

Pol Roger Rich Champagne (12%)

33% Pinot Noir, 34% Chardonnay and 33% Pinot Meunier. What makes Rich NV different from Brut Réserve is the increased dosage of 34 g/l of sugar which makes it the perfect drink for occasions when something a little less dry is called for. The nose opens with beguiling hints of beeswax and apricot which are repeated on the palate and reinforced with notes of acacia honey. £46.00

Moutard '6 Cepages' Champagne (12.5%)

Did you know that six grape varieties are permitted in Champagne?? Not many people do, which is why this is so different and special. Alongside the usual suspects of chardonnay, pinot noir and pinot meunier are arbanne, petit meslier and pinot blanc. This all blends together to give a rich complex wine that is smooth on the palate. £46.00

NV Veuve cliquot, Yellow Label Brut Champagne (12%)

The Cliquot name was established I 1772 by Phillippe Clicquot, His son Francois inherited and Married Nicole Ponsardin, after the early death of Francois, Veuve Clicquot Ponsardin began to produce vintage champagne's of the highest quality. Perhaps the most famous is the Veuve Clicquot Ponsardin Yellow Label Champagne, which is recognised as a superiour champagne to many.. Full of body Soft delicate colouring, positive fruit, a real taste of quality. and class. £46.00

Veuve Cliquot Rosé Champagne (12.5%)

Made very much in the style of it's famous sibling Veuve Clicquot Yellow Label the Rosé is dominated by Pinot Noir and uses 100% Premier and Grand Cru grapes. The Champagne itself is very stylish with a refined and soft texture. A lovely creamy red fruit infused flavour and the same dry crisp style of Yellow Label with tremendous freshness. Complex, soft and full flavoured with a rich raspberry and blackcurrant nose and palate. £50.00

Laurent Perrier Rosé Champagne (12%)

Salmon-pink in colour. The nose is precise and very crisp with a lasting impression of freshness, it has hints of soft red fruits, such as strawberries, redcurrants, raspberries and black cherries. Intensely fruity flavours begin clean and well-defined upon entry, the wine then opens up to a melange of flavours consisting of fresh strawberries, raspberries and wild cherries. It has great length and is rounded and supple on the finish. £55.00

Rose Wine

Broken Shackle Rosé, Australia (12.5%)

The generous fruit palate lingers with sweet raspberry, red current and cherry notes which are beautifully balanced by the crisp acid finish. A classic rose

Le Campuget Syrah Grenache Rosé, France (13%)

Chateau de Campuget is a top quality family owned estate in Costieres de Nimes with a history dating back several centuries. Pale pink, with a delicate fresh strawberry nose. Red fruits, medium body with a soft rounded finish.

Pinot Grigio Blush Sollazzo Premio, Umbria, Italy (12.5%)

The appealing pale blush colour of this wine is obtained from the skins of the Pinot Grigio grapes which are pink in colour. Delicate aromas of strawberries and raspberries with soft ripe berries on the finish.

Sunset Point Zinfandel blush, California (10.5%)

Wyld Wood Organic Cider 6.5% (500ml)

Produced entirely from English grown organic cider apples and fermented in old oak vats, Weston's award winning organic cider has a ripe apple aroma and well balanced fruity taste. This is a very likeable, well balanced and fruity drink with pleasant floral scent and taste, complete with a long, sweet, earthy, appley finish £3.90

Old Rosie Cloudy Scrumpy 7.3% (500ml)

Award winning Old Rosie Scrumpy is allowed to settle out naturally after fermentation resulting in a truly old fashioned, full flavoured, appley, cloudy scrumpy; with a well balanced medium dry character. Suitable for vegetarians, vegans and coeliacs.. £3.90

Wyld Wood Organic Pear Cider 6% (500ml)

Traditionally made from selected organically grown pears. Lightly sparkling, fresh and fruity with a rich pear flavour. (Commended at Soil Association's 2008 Food Awards.) £4.00

Locally bottled Beers & Lagers

Geltsdale Brewery Lager 4.5% (330ml)

Lager

A real chill conditioned Lager, brewed with fresh Geltsdale water. A clean tingling body, with a hint of citrus designed to be refreshingly morerish. £3.40

Geltsdale Brewery Cold Fell Pale Ale 3.9% (500ml)

Pale Ale

Brewed with lager malt to produce a refreshingly crisp pale ale with a fresh white head, and fragrantly bittered using Bobek and Cascade hops. £4.00

Allendale Adder Lager 5.0% (330ml)

Pilsner style lager

Slow fermented and traditionally lagered at zero degrees for 8 weeks, this is a crisp refreshing pilsner style lager. Winner of overall beer of CAMERA Newcastle festival £3.50

Wylam Locomotion No..1 5.0% (500ml)

Continental style lager

Brewed in Northumberland and made with lager and Vienna malts and the famous saaz hop. Traditionally lagered for 3 weeks at 1 degree Celsius to produce the distinctive smooth blend of hops and malt £4.00

Hadrian and Border Tyneside Blonde 3.9% (500ml)

Blonde ale

A pale coloured thirst-quencher using Maris Otter malt, wheat malt and an abundance of bittering and aromatic hops. Slightly creamy and easy to drink. £3.90

Allendale Golden Plover 4.0% (500ml)

Blonde Ale

Made using only Marris Otter pale malt to give a light and refreshing clean taste. Moderately hopped with Challenger and delicate New Zealand Hallertau hops. This is the perfect easy drinking beer for hot summer days! £3.90

Wylam Bohemia 4.6% (500ml)

Czech style pilsner

Twice finalist great British beer festival Bohemia is made to a Czech recipe - Pale and Carapils malts, Tettnanger Saz and Hallertau Hersbrucker hops, and using a Czech strain of Pilsner yeast. Deep gold with a rich hop character. £4.00

Wylam Rocket 5.0% (500ml)

Best Bitter

Multi Award Winner! A pale copper traditional best bitter. Deceptively easy drinking with a fresh citrus and aromatic character from the Centennial hops. Good bitter finish £4.00

Hadrian and Border Farne Island Bitter 4.0% (500ml)

Amber bitter

An amber coloured bitter, perfectly blended malt and hops makes this well-rounded beer balanced and refreshing. £3.90

Jarrow brewery Rivet Catcher 4.0% (500ml)

Gold bitter

Winner of North East Beer of 2005 and Silver Medal winner at Great British Beer Festival 2005. Light, smooth and satisfying with subtle fruity hops that give the taste profile on the tongue and nose. £3.90

Durham brewery Cloister 4.5% (500ml)

Modern Bitter/Pale Ale

A simple malt grist of maris otter pale malt and a small amount of crystal malt is bittered and aromatized by a complex addition of a unique blend of hops. English, Czech and American hops mingle throughout the boil to give a heady flowery aroma, and a tantalising peachy flavour, offset by a refreshing degree of bitterness. £4.00

Hadrian and Border Tyneside brown ale 4.7% (500ml)

Brown Ale

Brown ale is a style of beer with a dark amber or brown colour and the term "brown ale" was first used by London brewers in the late 17th century. This brown ale is brewed on Tyneside. It is a full bodied, nutty, dark amber beer balanced with traditional English bittering and aroma hops. £4.10

Allendale Wolf 5.5% (500ml)

Ruby Bitter

A beautiful red coloured, full-bodied beer taking its name from the famous Wolf of Allendale. With bitterness coming from Challenger hops and a fruity blackcurrant aroma coming from Williamette hops. At 5.5% abv. this really is beer with a bite! £4.00

Allendale Wagtail 3.8% (500ml)

Session Bitter

A traditional amber coloured session beer with a difference. The strong flavour belies the relatively low alcohol content. A slightly spicy aroma comes from Goldings and Fuggles hops, with the bitterness from English Target. £3.90

Hadrian and Border Ouseburn Porter 5.2% (500ml)

Porter

Porter was first recorded as being made and sold in London in the 1730s. It became very popular in Great Britain and Ireland, and was responsible for the trend toward large regional breweries. Ouseburn is a traditional, robust and satisfying Porter made with the finest of ingredients. £4.20

Durham Brewery Benedictus 8.4% (500ml)

Barley Wine

A complex blend of hops give an interesting depth and balancing bitterness. The finish lingers with a rich warmth. Even so, there are still enough unfermented malt sugars that fill out body and mouth-feel. Peach and pear drops mingle with the sheer weight of alcohol. Bottle-conditioning and a unique blend of hops balance the caramel flavour of crystal malt. The overall impression is of a fully integrated, characterful richness. £4.25

Durham Brewery Temptation 10% (500ml)

Russian Style Stout

Brewed using Crystal malt, amber malt, black malt and roast barley in generous quantities generate a deep black colour and flavours to match. Roast bitterness, coffee and liquorice notes combine in a velvety rich malt texture. A full and sweetish body is balanced by traditional Goldings hops. £4.50
